



Teal Ribbon 5k run/walk – Team Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Team?

A team is a group of runners/walkers, collectively raising money through fundraising. Often teams participate in honor or memory of a loved one affected by ovarian cancer. Team members can include family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, and all those who share the desire to help raise funds to advance ovarian cancer research. The creator of the team is the **Team Captain**.

What does it mean to be Team Captain?

Team captains are the organizer's of the team and the liaison between the team members and the Teal Ribbon Ovarian Cancer Research Foundation. They will encourage participation and fundraising on-line and collect off-line monies from team members. The Team captain will turn in off-line fundraising at the run/walk in May 30, 2010.

Do we have to fundraise?

There are no requirements for team to raise funds.

Are there Team fundraising incentives?

The Team Challenge is based on Teal Ribbon 5k run/walk Registration & Team Fundraising.

We challenge your team to encourage participation in the Teal Ribbon 5k run/walk through registration & to raise \$ 2,000.00 by **April 10, 2010**.

- As of the date you raise \$2,000.00, **All Teal Ribbon 5k run/walk registered Team Members** will receive a unique gift.
- The gift for all registered team members will be mailed to the Team Captain.
- The unique gift is only available to teams who raise \$2,000.00 by April 10, 2010.

How will our team members find each other the day of the Teal Ribbon 5k run/walk?

Teams are encouraged to wear team shirts, hats, pins or other costumes. Be creative!
