The Teal Ribbon Ovarian Cancer Research Foundation, Inc. is a nonprofit 501 (c) (3) organization that is dedicated to raising funds for ovarian cancer research and supports cutting-edge research programs towards a cure: advocating for early diagnostic treatment programs to improve the lives of ovarian cancer survivors. The foundation was started as a result of Kristen Varley, who was diagnosed at age 38, with stage IIIc ovarian cancer. Kristen was a runner prior to her diagnosis and had no symptoms and no family history. Cancer does not discriminate - all women are at risk and currently, there is no screening test and no cure.
